

## 【Search Rules】

(1) The symbols of Boolean Logic :

+ or (blank space) both mean 'AND'.

(※The blank space between word and word of an English sentence is regarded as + )

| means 'OR', - means 'NOT'.

(2) For the sake of search efficiency/speed, the search fields only accept Chinese (simplified/traditional) and English letters, and do not accept any signs, symbols, marks, characters and Arabic numerals. But '-' can be accepted in English search. (Please note, the single quotation marks '' added around – are necessary.) Plus, to delete all the symbols in an English-sentence search is also necessary.

<Example 1> Correct search

Chinese search: 蔣介石

English search: computer

English search: 'OPEN-MINDED'

(※ You must enter 'OPEN-MINDED' instead of OPEN-MINDED, because the latter will be regarded as OPEN NOT MINDED)

<Example 2> When you enter 'OPEN-MINDED'+快樂, then you will get all the articles/results including these two terms at the same time OPEN-MINDED and 快樂.

<Example 3> Incorrect search

'中國' ('' should be deleted)

中國 123 (123 can not be accepted)

中國 abc (correct search : 中國+abc)

123 (numbers can not be accepted)

中國&\* (symbols can not be accepted)

<Example 4> System automatically corrects the wrong searches

+中國

|中國

-中國

All the wrong searches above will be automatically regarded as 中國.

中國+北京

The wrong search above will be automatically regarded as 中國+北京.
